

BASES Y HANDBOOK OF ANNOUNCEMENT

The National Paralympic Association of Peru (ANPPERÚ), as the highest governing body of the Parasport Movement in the country, and as the entity that governs Para Athletics in the national territory, chaired by Mrs. Luisa Villar Gálvez, and in coordination with the World Para Athletics (WPA) are pleased to invite you to the Segundo Open de Para atletismo – Lima 2024 which will take place from 29 April to 6 May 2024.

The National Para athletes who participate in this Open must be duly registered by their respective base clubs, this includes having the 2024 Active License. All registration must be carried out by the Club except for Para athletes with Intellectual Disabilities who must be registered. by FEDEPEDI. Only registrations from clubs affiliated with ANPPERÚ will be received.

In the event that Para Athletes from abroad who wish to take part in the competition, they must abide by the rules described in these Rules and Call Manual and must be officially presented by their respective National Paralympic Committee (NPC), which will endorse that he is a certified Para athlete. The Local Organizing Committee (LOC) reserves the right to invite, at the discretion of the organization, to certain Para Athletes to strengthen some tests or to that take part in specific controls.

The objective of these Bases is to outline the duties and rights that all participants in the Segundo Open de Para atletismo – Lima 2024 must comply with and the steps to follow for their correct registration in the event.

1. ABOUT LIMA AND PERU

1.1. CITY AND COUNTRY

Lima, the capital of Peru, hosts the Segundo Open de Para atletismo – Lima 2024 at the Villa Deportiva Nacional (VIDENA) stadium, which was rebuilt in 2019 for the Pan American and Parapan American Games.

1.2. CURRENCY

The currency of Peru is the Sol (PEN), but the American dollar (USD) can also be used.

1.3. LANGUAJE

The official language is Spanish, spoken by 84 percent of the population. In addition, 47 native languages are spoken in the country, including Quechua and Aymara.

1.4. TEMPERATURES

Average temperature throughout the year: 15°C/25°C – 59°/77°F Average temperature in May: 18°C/21°C –59°/66.2°F

3. COMPETITION

3.1. DATE

Friday 3, Saturday 4 Y Sunday 5 of May of 2024.

3.2. **VENUE**

Athletic Stadium, National Sports Village (VIDENA). Mondo track, withanA-1 certification by World Athletic.

3.3. ADDRESS

Av. Canadá cuadra 10 s/n, puerta 10, San Luis.

3.4. BRIEF DESCRIPTION

The Athletic Stadium, with capacity for 6,500 people, is one of the venues built for the Lima 2019 Pan American and ParaPan American Games and is today managed by the Legacy Project. The Lima 2019 Athletics and Para Athletics competitions, the South American Senior Athletics Championship, the Ibero-American Master Championship have been held here, and it has already been designated to host the U20 World Championship in 2024 by the World Athletics.











It has a Class-1 track where the competitions take place. Close to this, there is a Class-2 training and warm-up track, both approved by the World Athletics.

4. COMPETITION FORMAT

The Para athletics competition format for the Segundo Open de Para atletismo – Lima 2024 is as follows:

4.1. TRACK EVENTS

In the track events, the series or finals will be determined based on the number of competitors.

4.2. FIELD EVENTS

All field events will be defined according to the number of entries received for each event. **Note:** The types of events will be defined based on the number of registered in each one

5. COMPETITION PROCEDURES

In order to carry out an organized and successful event, the following rules established by World Para Athletics will govern the procedures of the competition:

5.1. QUESTIONS

Any question related to the technical management of the Para Athletics competition must be submitted in writing to the following email address: insopenparaatletismolima@gmail.com no later than May 1 at 10:00 a.m. These questions will be answered, and the answers will be sent to all team delegation heads by mail before the technical meeting no later than may 2 at 01:00 p.m.

5.2. FINAL CONFIRMATION OF ENTRIES

At the end of the technical meeting, the team leader must make the final confirmation to the LOC about the registrations of the competitors to the events. Forms for final confirmation of trial entries will be distributed to teams before or during the technical meeting.

For the universal relay, the names of the four participants and the names of their respective guide runners must be presented, in order of departure, at the Technical Information Center (TIC) of the Athletic Stadium (VIDENA) no later than 4:00 p.m. day before the competition.

5.3. NUMBER BIBS

The Bibs will be delivered at the technical meeting to the accredited delegates. Those that have not been collected in a timely manner will be delivered to the Technical Information Center of the Atlético Stadium (VIDENA).

In case of loss of the bibs, it could be replaced by one assigned by the Local Organizing Committee upon payment of US\$15 or its equivalent in national currency (PEN).

5.4. CALL ROOM

There will be two call rooms for all field and track events. The first will be located in the area adjacent to the warm-up area (close to the finish line). Boards with information about the presentation schedule will be installed in the first call room.











Athletes must report to the first call room according to the official schedule of their event. Here is a preliminary schedule:

Jump events	approx. 50 minutes before the official start of the test
Seated throwing events	approx. 30 minutes before the official start of the test
Standing throwing events	approx. 50 minutes before the official start of the test
Track events	approx. 30 minutes before the official start of the test

Note: Note: the time of the final call assigned to each event will be confirmed at the technical meeting.

An official will escort the athletes to the second call room, located between the warm-up and competition areas. The same procedure will apply to guides runners and assistants entering the field with an athlete.

5.5. ENTRY TO THE COMPETITION AREA

All athletes, guide runners and assistants, accompanied by competition officials, must enter the competition area directed by the officials. No athlete or assistant may leave the competition area during an event, without the permission of the head judge. When an athlete or assistant must leave the competition area, an official must escort them.

6. RULES, UNIFORMS Y SPORTS EQUIPMENT

The regulations, uniforms and equipment for the Para Athletics competition must meet the requirements detailed in the following documents, which will be in force during the Segundo Open de Para atletismo – Lima 2024:

- Manual of competition uniforms

7. ATHLETES UNIFORM

All athletes must compete in the uniform approved by their delegation. For the medal ceremony, present yourself with the uniform official of its Delegation.

7.1. SPORTS EQUIPMENT

7.1.1. RACING CHAIRS AND THROWING BENCHES

Racing chairs and throwing benches arriving at the airport will be taken directly to the competition field. This equipment will be stored in the LOC warehouses.

A pre-check of racing chairs and throwing benches will be done. All racing chairs and throwing chairs will be checked in the call room before being taken to the competition field.

7.2. IMPLEMENTS

Personal implements must be registered for competition before 4:00 p.m. the day before the competition at the TIC.

8. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

Protests and appeals will be resolved in accordance with the WPA Rules and Regulations. Appeals must be in writing and must indicated the rule number to which it











refers, signed by a responsible official from each Delegation on behalf of the athlete or team, and must be accompanied by an appeal fee of 200 USD or 800 PEN.

10. MEDALS AND DIPLOMAS

In the Para Athletics competition, gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded per event. Participation diplomas will be awarded to all participating delegations.

10.1. VIABILITY CRITERIA OF THE COMPETITION

For individual sports, a competition will be viable when, in the Entries by name, there are four athletes from three countries or clubs entered in a single competition.

For the relay events, a minimum of four teams from four countries or clubs are required in the Entries by Name for the competition to be viable.

10.2. MEDAL COMPETITION

Any event, which has met the criteria after the Entry by Name, will be confirmed as a medal competition (a competition that awards medals to the winners in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the sport).

Once considered viable, the competition will maintain its status as a competition of medal.

Any competition that, later of the Inscription, No comply with the criteria of viability, can become in a competition without medal. A competition without a medal will not award medals and will not be considered for the OPEN ranking.

10.3. MEDALS COMPETITION SCHEDULE

The Program of medal events will be published after Registration, no later than April 15, 2024, and will present the complete list of medal events and non-medal events.

Once the Final Medal Event Schedule has been published, all medal events will remain as such, and the IF Rules and Regulations for awarding medals will apply, and the At Least One Rule where necessary.

11. SPORTS INFORMATION and TECHNICAL INFORMATION CENTER

The Information Center will be located in the VIDENA Athletic Stadium, on the first floor.

11.1 COMPETITION SCHEDULE

The competitions will take place over three days with two daily sessions between 9:00. and 18:00. Details, such as start time, events, competition, gender, class and stage per session, will be provided after registrations from Delegations have been received.

11.2 VENUE AND TRAINING SCHEDULE.

The Para Athletics training will take place on the warm-up track in VIDENA, as follows:

ATHLETIC STADIUM WARM-UP TRACK (VIDENA):

During the competition, the warm-up track will be available to all athletes competing in each session, two hours before the start of the competition.

The implements and sports equipment will be in the equipment store located next to the track. Athletes using the equipment will have to hand in their Lima 2024 OPEN identification and accreditation card to the responsible staff.

The medical service will be implemented during training and competition at both venues, along with the ambulance service.

12. TECHNICAL MEETING

The technical meeting will take place on Thursday, May 2 at 4:00 p.m. at the Pista Atlética Videna. Two representatives of each Delegation may attend accompanied by an interpreter or attaché, if necessary.

Questions must be submitted by email or at the Sports Information Center no later than Thursday, May 2 at 10:00. Questions will not be accepted during the technical meeting.

In the meeting will provide new information and updates that have not been mentioned in this Sports Technical Manual, including the following:

- Presentation of the Technical Delegate and the main officials of Segundo Open de Para atletismo Lima 2024
- Report times in call rooms
- Changes in the schedule (if applicable)











- Starting heights and elevation of the bar for vertical jumps.
- Protests and appeals
- Medal ceremony

13. ACCREDITATION

Accreditations will be delivered until May 2, prior to the start of the competition. Requests for accreditation must be received by the LOC no later than March 20, 2024.

13.1. ACOMMODATTION

The Local Organizing Committee offers the opportunity for Para athletes and Delegation officials to stay in the residential blocks of the Pista Atlética Videna.

They are rooms with up to four beds.

The rooms are equipped with furniture that provides a comfortable stay for residents, based on previous experiences from the Lima 2019 ParaPan American Games.

13.2. FOOD SERVICES

The food service will take place in the dining room of the housing block located on the fourth floor of the Videna Athletic Track.

To access the main dining room, participants with their accreditation granted by the Segundo Open de Para atletismo – Lima 2024 LOC.

13.3. MAIN DINING ROOM

The main dining room will be located in the Videna lodging center and will work during the following hours:

Breakfast: 06:30-08:30 hours

Lunch: 12:00-2:00 p.m.

Dinner: 7:00 p.m. – 09:00 p.m.

Menus will be prepared in collaboration with food providers and sports nutritionists and will be previously published.

14. MEDICAL SERVICES

Medical facilities and an ambulance will be available at the competition venue. Emergency services and sports therapy will be available at the competition and training facility.

14.1. ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

Anti-doping control at the SEGUNDO OPEN DE PARA ATLETISMO - LIMA 2024 will be carried out in accordance with the provisions of the IPC and WADA (World Anti-Doping Association) Anti-Doping Code. The Local Organizing Committee will carry out random controls in coordination with the National Anti-Doping Commission.

15. FUNCTIONAL MEDICAL CLASSIFICATION

During the SEGUNDO OPEN DE PARA ATLETISMO - LIMA 2024 national and international functional medical classification will not be carried out. All Para athletes arriving from abroad to compete in Lima must present the 2024 License and confirmed international classification.

16. TRANSPORTATION FOR ATHLETES AND TEAM OFFICIALS ARRIVED FROM ABROAD

Arrival(only April 30 and May 1) and (only May 06) departure services from the Jorge











Chávez International Airport to the Accommodation Village and vice versa. The luggage will be transported entirely in cargo trucks provided by the logistics area. However, personal luggage authorized by Logistics whose dimensions do not exceed 55 cm will be allowed on board the buses. high x 40 cm. wide and 25 cm. background. The maximum weight is 15 kilos.











Track Map
